

# Prospect Broadview Bowling Club Inc CLUB COACH

The Prospect Broadview Bowling Club (PBBC) is seeking the services of a Club coach for the 2025-26 Pennant season. Ideally the candidate will be a playing coach however non-playing applicants will be considered.

# About Us

Set within the Broadview sporting precinct Prospect Broadview Bowling club is only ten minutes from the centre of Adelaide. The club has three excellent lawn greens with each one comprising of seven rinks. New state of the art LED lighting encompasses all our greens ensuring availability for night time play.

Season 2024-25 saw PBBC field three pennants' teams on Wednesday (Div 3E, 3N & 4E), two teams on Thursday (Div 1 & 2) and four teams on Saturday (Div,4,5,6 & 7).

The club has a full-time membership base of 100 members with an additional 45 social members. Whilst we maintain regular memberships the mission for the club in 2025-26 is to ensure a significant membership growth. To do this we recognise the need for greater bowls experience and leadership within the playing group. Many of our newer players are still developing their skills, and while they are training regularly to improve, the club believes it would benefit from a structured coaching approach to accelerate their development.

# Responsibilities

The general role of the club coach is to lead and coach the club for Pennant games and interclub competitions. Coaching for new bowlers is undertaken by other Club members with mentoring experience.

#### Job Description

The appointed coach will:

- Monitor and implement solutions to improve the performance of all pennant sides
- Develop and conduct team practices to ensure all sides play competitive and informed bowls to improve their grading during the playing season
- Provide 1 on 1 coaching for members
- Assist with the development and execution of a Competition Strategy for each side for the Pennant Season
- Assist with the establishment of a Player Development Program for individuals and groups of players
- Teach skills, techniques, and tactics tailored to different learning needs and player development stages.
- Guide players on the specific roles of lead, second, third, and skip.
- Use effective communication and feedback strategies to enhance player learning.
- Support team-building initiatives and identify player strategies to maximize performance
- Report to and advise the PBBC board as required

- Assist to further refine and improve the Selection Policy & procedure
- The club coach will work with and support the selection panel and attend selection meetings
- Contribute to a harmonious club environment

### Essential skills and experience

- Hold current Bowls Australia recognised coaching accreditation
- Strong management skills
- Good communication skills and the ability to interact with the whole club
- Is a supportive leader for all club members
- References relevant to personal characteristics, playing and coaching background

#### Renumeration

Renumeration for the position is available and negotiable. An indication is required of the renumeration package and any special conditions in the application. The appointment is for the 2025-26 Pennant Season with future options available subject to performance and outcomes. The coach is expected to commence at the beginning of August to establish early influence.
